#### Internship Program

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Allowed students to receive academic credit for work performed while learning about the broadcast industry. The Internship program is on-going. It is open to any college student who maintains a GPA of 2.5 or higher, is recommended in writing by a faculty member in their

respective major, and is able to work a minimum of 10 hours a week for academic credit. Interns work in various departments including: News/Public Affairs, Programming/Productions, Marketing/Sales, and Promotions.

#### 6 Scholarship Programs

Company Chairman/CEO has established a scholarship for Communications students at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to assist qualified students needing financial aid to pursue studies leading to a career in media. The Curtis Foundation has established the Bessemer City Curtis Scholars Program that will present four annual high school Scholarships each year. Each scholarship will be \$5k payable in four payments over four years. To renew the scholarship for each of the four years, the student must maintain a 2.5 GPA and have either a summer internship, summer job or be on a course of study or travel. Renewals will be confirmed by the selection committee. The grants will be paid directly to the college of choice selected by the student.

#### 14 Management Training

On a continuous basis we provide training to management level personnel as to methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity. Our President, Phil Zachary, counsels General Managers on a quarterly basis in ways to promote diversity in hiring.
