



Mount Tabor rode its suffocating defensive prowess and highoctane offense to an 11-3 finish in 2017, including a Piedmont Triad 3A title with a perfect 6-0 conference record, under first-year Head Coach Tiesuan Brown. The Spartans hit their stride in Week 6, registering 8 straight wins while scoring 35.6 ppg and allowing only 12 ppg during that stretch. Mt. 
