



## **NCAA BUFFALO BROTHERS BRACKET RULES**

### **How to Play**

The object of this game is given a bracket of 64 teams (we will not be counting the play in game) predict the winner of each game through the National Championship, the one who scores the highest number of points wins

### **Rules**

- 1) All brackets are to be received by a manager at Buffalo Brothers by 11:59 PM Wednesday March 17<sup>th</sup>, there are no exceptions
- 2) Anyone that is caught trying to cheat (IE trying to change their picks during the tournament) will be disqualified
- 3) Your picks and other information on your bracket must be legible and in permanent ink, if not the pick or information is automatically wrong or discounted.
- 4) Any bracket is acceptable but the 96rock/Buffalo Brothers brackets are preferred

### **Scoring and Prizes**

Our Philosophy is the person that wins the bracket pool should have a strong overall bracket and not just one that has the final four and the national champion correct. So this is a balanced scoring per round format

Round 1: 32 picks \* 1 point/pick = 32 points  
Round 2: 16 picks \* 2 points/pick = 32 points  
Round 3: 8 picks \* 3 points/pick = 24 points  
Round 4: 4 picks \* 5 points/pick = 20 points  
Round 5: 2 picks \* 8 points/pick = 16 points  
Round 6: 1 pick \* 12 points/pick = 12 points

Total 136 points

The 1000 dollar cash prize will be determined by who gets the highest score, in the event of a tie breaker we will use the question that asks how many points total will be scored in the national championship game, if that doesn't break the tie the tying brackets will be compared beginning with the championship game for correct number of picks/round.
