## 94.7 WQDR MORNING SHOW NOMINATED FOR ACM AWARD AS ON-AIR PERSONALITIES OF THE YEAR

**RALEIGH, NC** (February 8, 2011) The Academy of Country Music (ACM) has announced its slate of nominees for the 46<sup>th</sup> Annual ACM Awards, and the Triangle's 94.7 WQDR is again in contention, this time for its highly-rated "Q Morning Crew" program. The show airs Monday through Friday mornings from 5:00 to 10:00AM and features Mike Wheless, Janie Carothers, Marty "The One Man Party" Young and veteran newsman Mike Raley. Other cities with radio stations in contention for the "On-Air Personality of the Year" award for "Large Markets" include Indianapolis, Milwaukee and Cincinnati. The winner will be announced on the ACM Awards Show live from Las Vegas, Sunday evening, April 3<sup>rd</sup>, on the CBS Television Network (locally, WRAL-TV).
